Michael J. Crowe, 85, passed away on Friday, August 16, 2019, at Staten Island University Hospital North.

He was born and raised in Torbay, Newfoundland, Canada, Michael immigrated to the U.S. in 1955, settling in the Sunset Park section of Brooklyn, where he and his wife, Theresa, raised their 3 daughters, Diane, Michele and Donna. In 2001 he moved to Great Kills.

He was a dock builder with Local Union 1456, where he was a 50 year honorary member. He retired in 1996. Michael was a man of faith and parishioner of St. Clare Church, where he was also a church usher. He was a "jack of all trades", always fixing something in the house and extending a helping hand to anyone who needed something fixed. His daughters' said "he could fix just about anything."

Michael enjoyed traveling with his wife, especially back home to his birth country, Canada, where he would often visit family. He was also an avid Yankee and Ranger's fan and was known for having a sweet tooth, never turning down chocolate or any kind of candy.

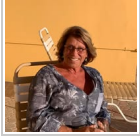
