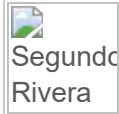

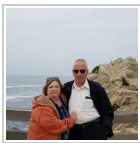

This lies real heavy in my chest, me and him started sanitation together and worked together every single night for about 8 months until he transferred out of Manhattan 9. He was open with me about his past addictions and I always tried to make his day as easy going as possible. My mother passed on Feb 12 and from late January until then we worked 12+ hour night shifts together with no days off (almost 54 days). I would spend sleepless days nursing my Mother for 3 weeks leading up to her death and he held me down as caring partner without even knowing why I was so tired. I didn't want the pity from anyone (kept it a secret) and he was there as a caring friend/supporter. Life is so spontaneous and i am deeply sorry for your loss. I wish I could have atleast known he was slippin. That was my boy man. RIP Mike you truly were a hero to me in one of my darkest times. You kept me sane. DAMN MAN!
