Mitchell loved smiling, and laughing and making the most out of every situation. Any given Sunday, you can find him rooting for the New York Jets., or watching the New York Mets or putting in his horse racing bets. He was known to pick a lot of winners.

Mitchell also had been blessed with a large family from coast to coast with 10 other brothers and sisters, lots of nieces and nephews, many cousins and aunts and uncles who all loved him very dearly. Everyone loved it when Mitch came to a party or event. It meant the life of the party was there.

He especially loved spending time playing board games with his God daughter/niece Angela, or reading the Lord of the rings, Harry Potter, and watching Game of Thrones and Stranger Things. He always made sure to go to every opening night of any Marvel/DC movie that was released! He can easily be found on his tablet and listening to music.
