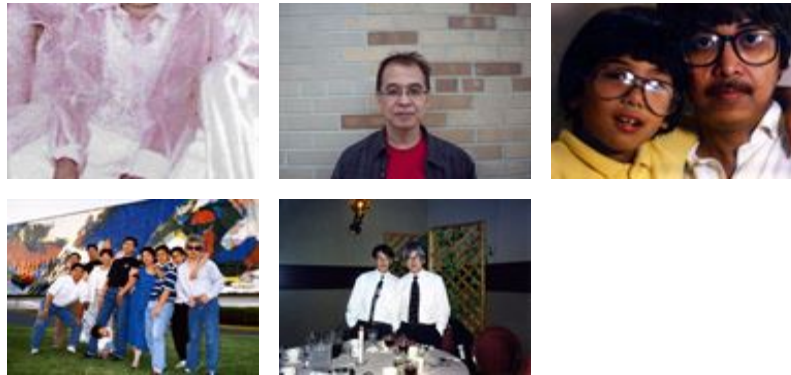

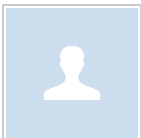

“ I've known Nick for over 40 years. I met him in 1980 while playing ball every Thursday evening at the gym of the United Nations International School in New York. It was also Nick who had subsequently helped me get a job at the United Nations where I worked in the same department with him for a number of years.

Among his many talents, Nick was also an avid photographer and so he became my wedding photographer at my first marriage. Nick was a loyal and trusted friend and so it was a no-brainer when I asked him to become our son, Jeffrey's, godfather. Nick would always invite us to his home on Staten Island where the parties would almost always happen in his basement where he would be playing bass along with his band.

Many years and memories later, Nick and his wife, Winnie, would join Aileen and me in a Catholic Charismatic covenant community in New Jersey where we were able to both serve the Lord and the larger Church through the community's many renewal and outreach programs.

Nick was a low-key, quiet, unassuming, kind and humble man but who nonetheless did what needed to be done, mostly in the background and with very few spoken words. I will always remember his soft voice and his simple yet reassuring smile.
