Patricia Grace Lamb passed away on March 11, 2017 with her family by her side. A native of Staten Island she attended Saint Margret Mary's and Saint Louis Academy High School. After graduation she attended nursing school at Flower 5th Avenue School for Nursing in Manhattan, where she met her loving husband and lifelong companion, Gerald. She devoted her life to her family and helping others. Patricia began her 50 plus year nursing career at Flower. She then transferred to the former Richmond Memorial Hospital and worked as an Obstetrics & Gynecology nurse. Passionate about her work for the developmentally disabled, she went back to school at C.W. Post (Long Island) to earn her Masters in Counseling. She then spent the majority of her career (over 30 years) as the Director of Nursing at Willowbrook School for the Developmentally Disabled. She finished her nursing career at Staten Island University Hospital (South), where she ran the Outpatient Clinics, for almost 20 years. She retired in 2006 to be a full time grandmother. She was a devoted Catholic and parishioner of St. Clare's. Patricia and her husband were Baptismal Ministers for the parish for over 20 years. Patricia loved knitting things for family and friends, shopping, cooking, reading and vacationing in Florida with her family.

Patricia the beloved wife of Gerald Lamb, who she was married to for 64 years, loving mother of Jerilynn and son-in-law Ralph Pagone, Stephen and
