Born in Brooklyn, New York, Phil proudly served his country in the Army during the Korean War from 1951 - 1953, and then came home and served in the Army Reserves until 1957 during which time he met the love of his life Mary, They married on Sept 18th, 1955 and were inseparable for over 64 years. He was a loving father to Joseph and Nina and to his 6 grandchildren Marissa, Philip, Anthony, Stephanie, Nicole and Cara.
