Raymond D. Moroz of Eltingville A Korean War Veteran passed away on Sunday December 18, 2016. He was the beloved husband of the late Mary. Devoted father of Raymond, Patricia DeCicco, Kathryn Moroz, Michael, Paul and Julie Gasca. He is also survived by his 10 grandchildren and his many loving nieces and nephews.

Born in Brooklyn he was a Chemist in the sugar industry working for Sucrest/Revere and Chris Hansen. Raymond was instrumental in developing the flavors in breakfast cereals. He obtained his Master's degree from City College of New York. Raymond was a man of varied talents and interests, he taught himself two languages, German and Spanish, he was an avid reader of History and Geography. He was a runner, a gardener, a collector of rocks, he also dabbled in photography and enjoyed art and classical music. He traveled the world extensively during his time in the Air Force and then for business as well as for pleasure.

A devout Catholic he was a volunteer at St. Clares as well as a devoted father, husband, & grandfather. He enjoyed bowling and was a sports enthusiast.

He a proud Veteran of the Air Force having served during the Korean War. With his background in Math and Engineering he was involved in the planning

and design of runways for landing of Military Air Craft. Later on in life he became intrigued by statistics and probability and used those talents to help predict the outcome of horse races based upon a jockey's past performance and past races of the horses. This was done for mostly speculation and theoretical means rather than betting odds.

Raymond was a member of the Fr. Drumgoole Council of the Knights of Columbus, a 50 year member of the American Chemists Society as well as a member of the American Museum of Natural History.

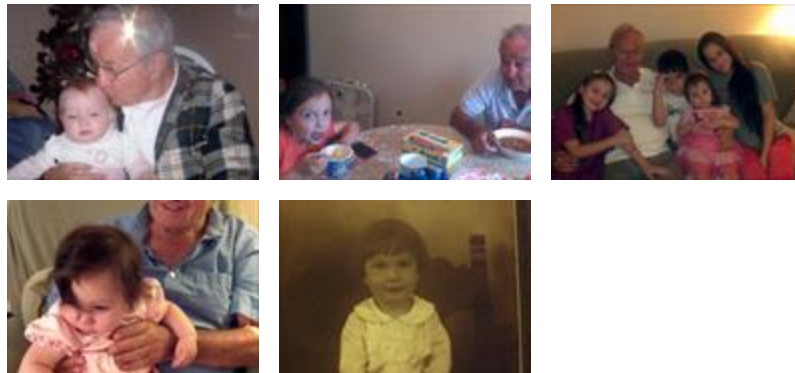
