Richard J. Franceschini, age 75, of Staten Island New York passed Monday, January 6, 2025, with the comfort of family by his side.

Richard was born to Aldo and Lucy Franceschini where he lived and spent most of his childhood on Jefferson Street with his sister, Irene Coughlin. It was there where he played baseball at the Berry Homes Field and graduated from New Dorp High School in 1966.

Richard served in the United States Navy during the Vietnam War and was appointed 2nd platoon leader on the USS Haleakala (AE-25) ammunition ship on January 11th 1967. He was honorably discharged in January of 1973.

Richard worked for the United States Post Office for 40 years where he was known as the "Merry Mailman". Beloved by colleagues with friendships remaining to this day.

Rich was loving, caring, and devoted to his family. He was a God-fearing man and dedicated to serving the lord. His ministry was to visit many in need with prayer and spread the gospel to all. His infectious laugh and sense of humor was a source of laughter at every family gathering. He was known for suddenly singing songs after hearing a word reminding him of the song, much like a human jukebox, and loved listening to artists like Sinatra and The

Beatles. Richard was a lifelong Yankees fan and his passion for baseball were his biggest hobbies.

Richard met the love of his life Margaret after returning from Vietnam in 1970. They married on November 17th 1973 at Saint Michaels Church in Mariners Harbor and enjoyed a loving and devoted marriage of 51 years. Their honeymoon was a tour in Europe including Luxembourg, Italy, France and Switzerland. Richard and Margarets' marriage was blessed with three children: Russell, Gilda, Adam and a cherished daughter in law Josmary, who he loved calling "Chiquita". He also shared a special bond with his grandson Sammy(of Gilda and Lenny), who he nicknamed "Scooch".
