Robert Joseph Arciero, 77, of Vero Beach Florida, long time resident of Staten Island, NY and Rochester, NH, died peacefully in his sleep surrounded by his family on July 29, 2019.

Mr. Arciero was born on the 10th day of May in 1942 in Manhattan to the late Vincent and Mary Arciero. Brother to the late Gerard, Vincent, and Lorraine Arciero. 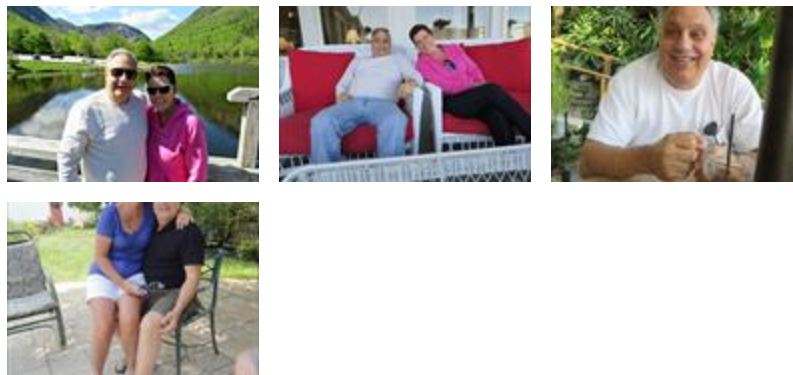

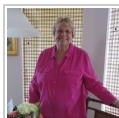
