Robert C. Marino, a retired Lieutenant Colonel from US Army passed away suddenly on Sunday January 22, 2017. Robert retired in 1995 as Director/Supervisor for Administration of Children's Services. Robert was born in Manhattan, graduated from La Salle Academy in 1955, obtained his BA from CUNY in 1961 and his Masters from Howard University in 1967. Robert had a career that was vast and varied. He worked as a Trainer-Supervisor for Special Services for Children in Staten Island, he also served as Executive Officer for United States Army Hospital in Fort Hamilton Brooklyn. He was the proud recipient of the Army Service Ribbon, The Overseas Ribbon, The National Defense Service Medal, The Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal, The Good Conduct Medal and the Army Commendation Medal. In March of 1980 he was promoted to Rank of Captain, in May of 1981 he received the Rank of Major and in June of 1988 he was elevated to Lieutenant Colonel.

Robert was an avid and devoted Yankee fan, he also enjoyed cooking, bowling and possessed an acute interest and knowledge of computers and electronics. He was a proud member of the American Legion.

His wife Lucy predeceased him passing away 6 years ago this month. He is survived by his two sons Robert and Christopher, his daughter Jennine Miller and her husband Charles and his 3 Grandchildren.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be offered on Thursday beginning at 9:30AM at St Thomas the Apostle Church. Burial will follow in Resurrection Cemetery with Military Honors.
