Robert A. Thompson of Princes Bay passed away on Thursday January 7, 2021 at the Center for Hope Hospice in Scotch Plains NJ. Born in Brooklyn to the late John and Mary, Robert served in the US Naval Reserves retiring in 1994. He was a Police Officer with NYPD at the 68th PCT in Brooklyn. After he finished his career with the NYPD he then went on to take a position with the New York City Health and Hospitals Corp serving as a Lieutenant with security at DownState Medical Center.
