Ronald Seggio, 54 of Staten Island, New York (Great Kills) died on Thursday, March 5, 2015, at Staten Island University Hospital North in Staten Island, New York.

He was born Saturday, April 30, 1960 in Manhattan and grew up in Woodside, Queens. He relocated to New Springville for 13 years before settling in Great Kills in 2001.
