



Roy J Ferlazzo

May 14, 1924 - October 2, 2019

Roy Joseph Ferlazzo, formerly of Winchester Avenue, Eltingville, son of the late Frank and Elvira Ferlazzo, died of natural causes at JFK Medical Center in Edison NJ, on Wednesday October 2. Roy was born in Jersey City, NJ on May 14, 1924 and grew up in Queens and the Bronx.

He was drafted into WWII 2 weeks after graduating high school and fought in the Army from 1943 to 1946 with the 3rd Army under General Patton in the 11th Armored Division, and ultimately fought in the Battle of the Bulge until the end of the war. He married Mildred Russotti on May 28, 1950, had their son, Frank in 1951 and settled in Staten Island soon after.

Roy was full of life, loved to joke, have fun, and had an incredible sense of humor. His love for his family was endless. Roy is a member of the 11th Armored Division Association, is a life member of the VFW post 5090, a life member of the Stolzenhaler Council #1675 Knights of Columbus, a member of the Veterans of the Battle of the Bulge, and a member of New Dorp and Great Kills senior citizens chapter and an Usher for 50 years at the 9 a.m. Mass at St. Clares

Roy is survived by his son Frank, daughter in-law Janet, grandchildren Darren and Jenna, great grandchildren Christopher, Evan and Patrick, and long time companion Julia Neves. Roy is also survived by a very large and loving

extended family.

A gathering of family and friends will take place on Saturday and Sunday from 2-5 & 7-9 p.m. A Mass of Christian Burial will be offered at St. Clares Church 110 Nelson Avenue on Monday at 9:45 a.m. Interment will follow in Resurrection Cemetery.

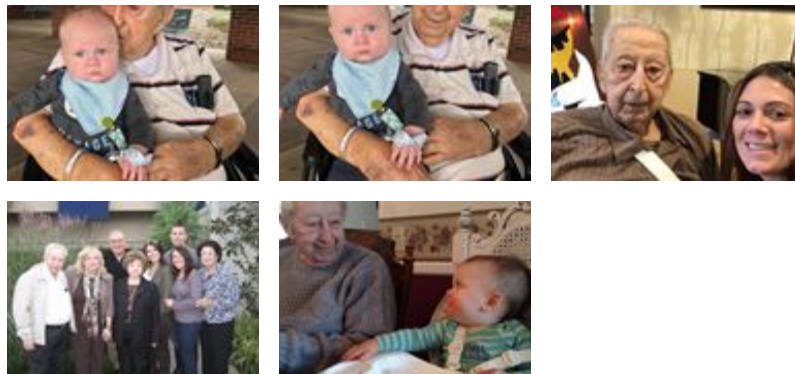
