Salvatore DeSimone, 93, passed away on Friday, May 31, 2019, at Golden Gate Health Care & Rehab. Center.

He was born and raised in the Redhook section of Brooklyn and in 2004 settled in Princes Bay. Salvatore was a billing clerk with Pennsylvania Railroad for many years and then took on a second career as a keypunch operator with Gibbs and Hill, an engineering firm. He retired in 1995.

Salvatore had a passion for playing the saxophone, starting as a teen, and continued his love of jazz and music throughout his life. He played at several clubs, including the the Brooklyn Paramount and various jazz clubs in Manhattan. He was Mets fan, enjoying watching the games and rooting his team on.
