Shirley M. Spacek, 89, passed away on November 23, 2017 at NY Weill Cornell M.C. in Manhattan surrounded by her loving family.

Born February 5, 1928, she was the daughter of the late Theodore and Mildred (Post) Otten, the Post family being early settlers of Staten Island. Shirley spent her early years in Mariners Harbor and has lived in Grant City for 80 years. She graduated New Dorp H.S. in 1946 and worked at Eger Nursing Home for 25 years, and also helped run the family business, New Way Chemical Corp.

A woman of strong faith, Shirley was secretary to the Pastors at Willowbrook and New Dorp Baptist Churches. She also taught Children's Bible Classes at Great Kills Gospel Chapel and the NY Women's Bible Society. For many years Shirley and her husband were representatives of the Billy Graham Association, showing world-wide picture films throughout the area. She loved well and was loved by all who knew her. Her legacy of faith has been passed to the generations that follow.

Shirley was predeceased by her beloved husband of 47 years, Edwin and her son, Timothy.

She is survived by her son, Daniel Spacek (Nina) of Maine, her daughter,

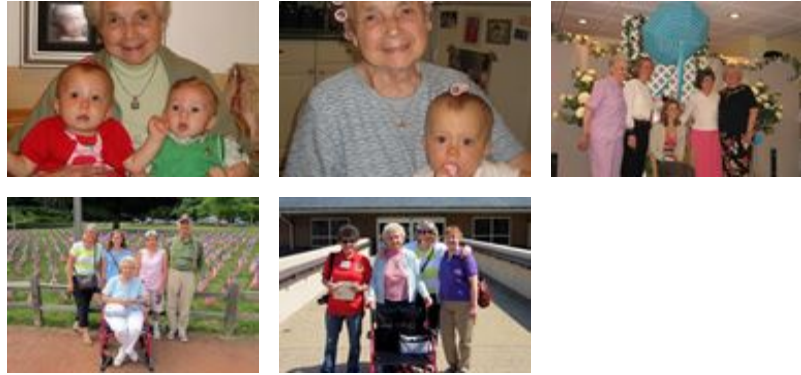
