July 13, 1935 - May 4, 2020

Teresa Deegan, 84 of Bay Terrace, Staten Island passed away peacefully in her home surrounded by her loving children on Monday, May 4, 2020. She was a parishioner of St. Charles Church in Oakwood, Staten Island.

Born in Glasgow, Scotland on July 13, 1935 to the late David Mckenna and Jane Monro, Teresa had a twin sister and was one of 17 children.

She immigrated to America in 1953 to stay with her aunt and uncle at the age of 18 and settled in the Bay Ridge section of Brooklyn, NY.

It was there that she met her husband, Frank Deegan, also a Scottish immigrant and married in 1957 at Our Lady of Angels Church, Brooklyn, NY. In 1980 they moved to the New Dorp section of Staten Island and in 1984, when she was only 49 years old, she lost her beloved husband at the age of 52. It was then that she took a job at Carmel Richmond Nursing Home until she retired in 2000.

Since coming to America Teresa made several visits back to Scotland. She spoke with her sister on a daily basis and loved being around her family, especially doting on her grandchildren. Teresa had a cute sense of humor; you could always count on her for a laugh. She loved playing scratch offs, playing the daily numbers and playing games on her iPad.

She is survived by her daughter Patricia Gogarty and her husband Thomas, her son Francis and his wife Mary, her son William and his wife Jen, and her sister Agnes Furlong. She is predeceased by her husband Frank and her son John. She is also survived by 4 grandchildren, Justine, Amanda, Thomas, and Maryann.

Due to the current corona virus pandemic funeral services will be held privately at the John Vincent Scalia Home For Funerals in Eltingville, Staten Island on Tuesday, May 12, 2020. Teresa will be buried at Oceanview Cemetery Staten Island, NY.

A memorial to celebrate Teresa's life will take place at a later date.
