Thaddeus, known affectionately as "Ted" to his friends and family and "Poppo" to his 7 grandchildren, was born on November 15, 1943 in Bay Ridge, Brooklyn, NY and passed away on April 27, 2025.

Ted was a devoted husband, loving father, proud Poppo and "Uncle Teddy" and dedicated friend to those he considered as family. He touched the hearts of all who knew him with his selflessness and unwavering commitment to those he held near and dear.

Ted retired from the NYPD after 20 years of service in 1985 and from the New York State Attorney General's office in 2014 after 27 years of service. He was passionate about traveling with his friends and family. You could often find Ted proudly adorned in his children's and grandchildren's school and sports team's attire. He was a staple on the Holy Child, St. Joseph Hill and Farrell sideline and never missed a milestone, game or school performance. 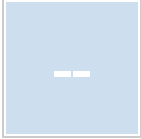
