



Thomas O. O'Neill

February 21, 1948 - December 14, 2016

Thomas O. O'Neill, 68 of Annadale, passed away on Wednesday, December 14, 2016, at Staten Island University Hospital, surrounded by his loving family.

Born Saturday, February 21, 1948 in Newark, New Jersey, he was the son of the late James O'Neill and the late Genevieve Mazur-Carriere. Thomas married the love of his life, Frances Nee Magnoli in 1970. Tom and Fran resided in Bensonhurst before moving to Annadale in 1989.

Thomas, proud of his Naval Service, enlisted in 1965 serving 4 years active duty. Lastly upon the USS Plymouth Rock, before serving 2 years of Naval Reserves. 5 years later Thomas again served another 2 year term of Naval Reserves retiring his service in 1979. Tom was also a member of the Tin Can Sailors.

Tom spent his early career working for Western Union, as a cableman from 1969-1986 and continued his career working for the FDNY as a Communications Electrician in 1986 where he retired in 2002. He was also member of IBEW Local 3 and CWA.

A man of many talents. Tom spent hours tinkering with projects and fixing cars. He loved the water and to be out on a boat. Tom will be remembered most for his honest and kind nature, his loyalty to friends and family, and as

many of his friends would say "he was truly One of the Good Guys!"

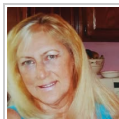

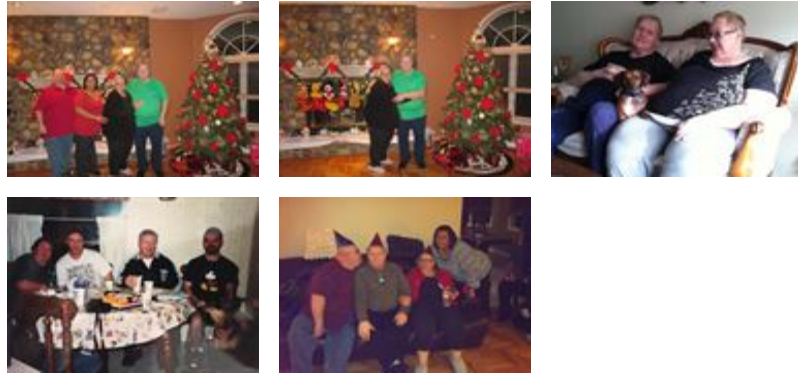
