Vincent Maligno Jr. of Elmont NY formerly of Staten Island passed away on December 29, 2019 at the age of 49. He was born on October 25, 1970 in Victory Memorial Hospital to Amelia and Vincent Sr. While his father served in the Air Force, Vincent traveled around the world, attending school on Anderson Air Force Base in Guam, and he continued school in Nuremberg Germany. After moving to Staten Island in 1981 he attended St. Teresa's School and after graduating he went to Tottenville High School. He then furthered his education by obtaining two Bachelor's Degree's one from SUNY Buffalo and the other from Rutgers University.. During 9/11 he served as a Paramedic for The FDNY. He then went to work for Assist Ambulance service, Midwood and Primary Care Ambulance services, and his last job was as a Paramedic for the jockeys with the New State Racing Authority at Aqueduct, Belmont and Saratoga race tracks.

Vincent enjoyed music, playing the guitar, he also was in a local band for many years. A warm kind person Vincent had a great sense of humor, always had a smile on his face, a hearty laugh and was the kind of person who would always help someone in need. He treasured time spent with family and was extremely fond of his niece Ava and was looking forward to the birth of his first nephew. He was devoted to his parents, his siblings and the rest of his family.

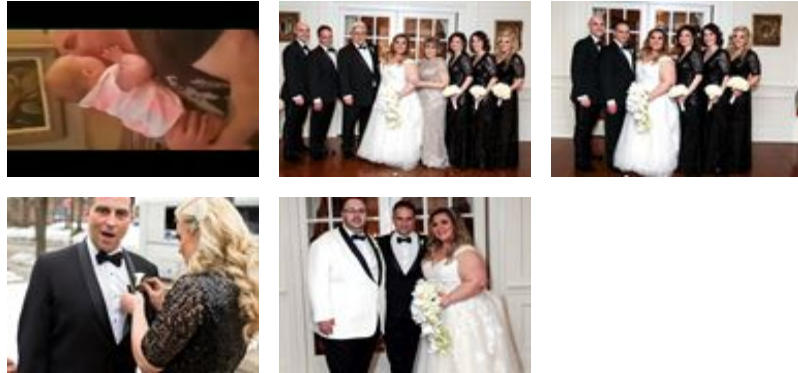
