Weimin worked at Staten Island New York State Institute for Basic Research for 35 years as research scientist.

On February 22 2026, she suffered a severe stroke while vacationing in Costa Rica. She was transferred via air ambulance back to a New York hospital, where she unfortunately passed away on March 18 following a monthlong battle with the medical after effects and a particularly unhelpful medical staff.

Weimin is survived by her husband Eddie and son Kevin.

Weimin was a loving wife and mother to her family, and never hesitated to help friends and relatives in any capacity. Coworkers and classmates would acknowledge her acute attention to detail; always giving her utmost effort to everything she committed to.
