He served honorably in the U.S. Army as a SP5 and was discharged in 1964. Bill then joined the NYC Police Department and during his tenure, he earned the rank of first grade detective and retired as a Lieutenant. He was on the arson explosion squad and was the commanding officer for Brooklyn South Narcotics. After his retirement in 1989 he joined the U.S. Coast Guard Auxillary. A man of faith, Bill was a longtime member and liturgist at Eltingville Lutheran Church. He was an O Gauge train enthusiast and in his spare time he enjoyed boating and vacations to Europe , Lake George and Florida with his wife and family. He also enjoyed spending summers in Elizaville, NY and the Catskills. He was a member of the Great Kills Swim Club and enjoyed every summer there. Bill was an extremely sociable man and always had an exciting story to tell, most being about the days of when he was on the police force.

Bill was predeceased by his beloved wife, Joan, who passed away in 2011. He is survived by his loving children, Karen McNeice-Merenda, William J. McNeice, III and Trevor M. McNeice and his adored grandchildren, Jessica Joan Merenda, Brooklynn Grace McNeice and Luke Austin William McNeice.

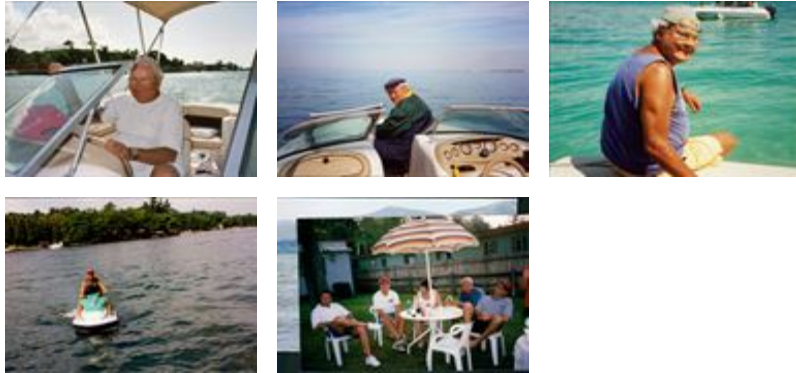
